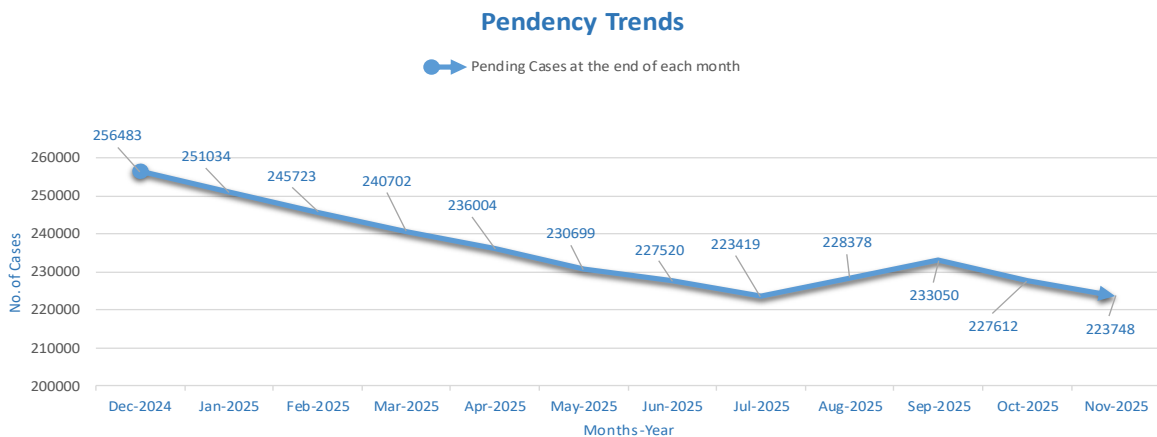
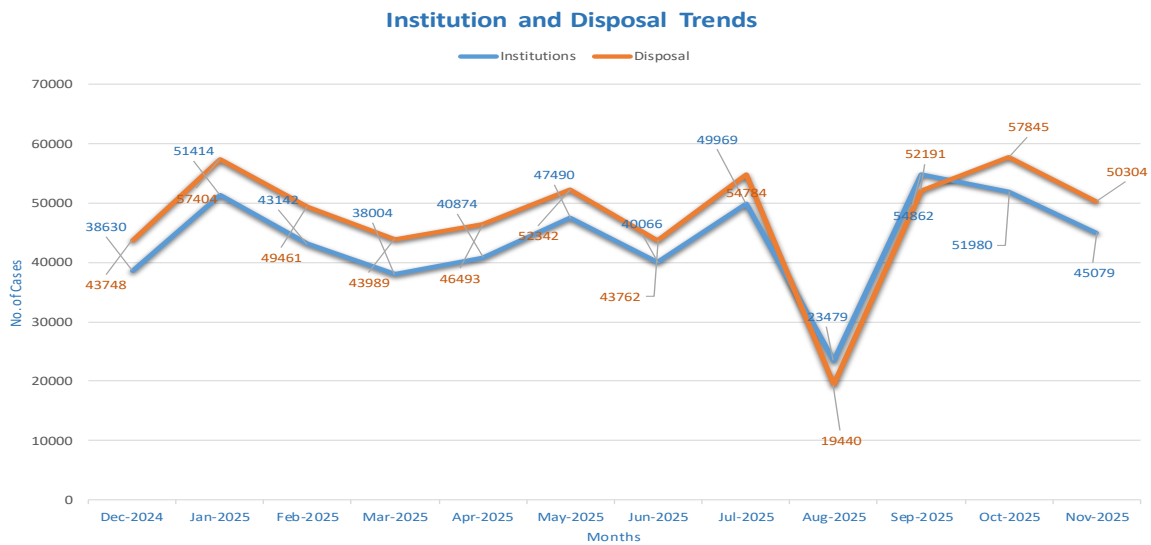

16. Pendency Variation:

Ideally to capture the accurate pendency, number of Transferred In cases must be equal to number of Transferred Out cases, but actually this is not happening in all the districts due to which capturing of actual pendency is difficult.

There is impact of transferred (in / out) cases on data accuracy. In the reporting month total 3480 cases were “transferred in” to the courts while 3243 cases were “transferred out” from one court to another. The difference of transferred in and out cases is -237 cases, which is one of the factors which affects pendency calculation. Updating the statistics is expected.

All districts need to update the PQS in respect of Transferred-In and Transferred-Out cases, otherwise accurate pendency cannot be reflected correctly.

Data audit of CFMIS by each Court and it timely updating would help resolve the issue.
