


Press Release

After submission of replies to the show-cause notices, proper opportunity of personal hearing was afforded to all the Judicial Officers. They were further provided opportunity of hearing before the Administration Committee of this Court.

After finding the thirteen Judicial Officers as guilty of the charge, the competent authority / Hon'ble the Chief Justice with the concurrence of Administration Committee has imposed upon them the major penalty of removal from service except Mr. Johar Ijaz Ali, Civil Judge, who has been exonerated of the charge.
